



Action Taken Report on Students' and Teachers' & Alumni Feedbacks on Syllabus

Most of the students were satisfied with the CBCS syllabus on the advanced topic and scope to choose inter disciplinary, intra disciplinary courses, skill-oriented papers and for more flexibility for students that allow them to study at different times and at different institutions to complete their specified course. From sampling process feedback was collected from the students on the basis of gender, year and course. Out of 100 respondents only 2 nos. of respondent had not given their response, 98 respondents gave their feedback regarding the above. Maximum students certified the syllabus as it is relevant for their career development.

Suggestion: -

1. Students: -

Few students were not satisfied with the syllabus pattern according to the order of the course, about the aim stated for each of the course, less percentage of course having practical components.

The syllabus should be more practical based. The elective courses should be more hours oriented and the core course should be reduced.


2. Teacher

According to alumni suggestion, IQAC has decided to conduct more career guidance programme related to specific subject which is more beneficial for the students.


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
